How to construct sector portfolios

How to choose your sectors?

Top-down

Analyze business cycles to position toward sectors that potentially could benefit more from the current economic phase

Bottom-up

Use aggregated company-level data to identify sectors with attractive fundamental characteristics, such as cheaper valuations and/or stronger earnings sentiment

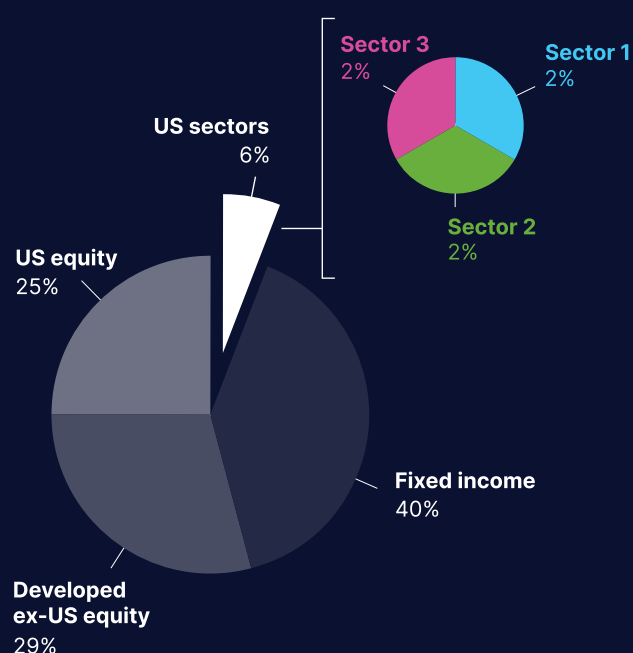
Thematic

Survey macroeconomic data (oil, inflation, rates) to position according to changes in macroeconomic variables. Identify cyclical or secular industry trends to harness growth potential within a particular segment of the economy

Technical

Evaluate recent performance to overweight/underweight sectors with strong price momentum

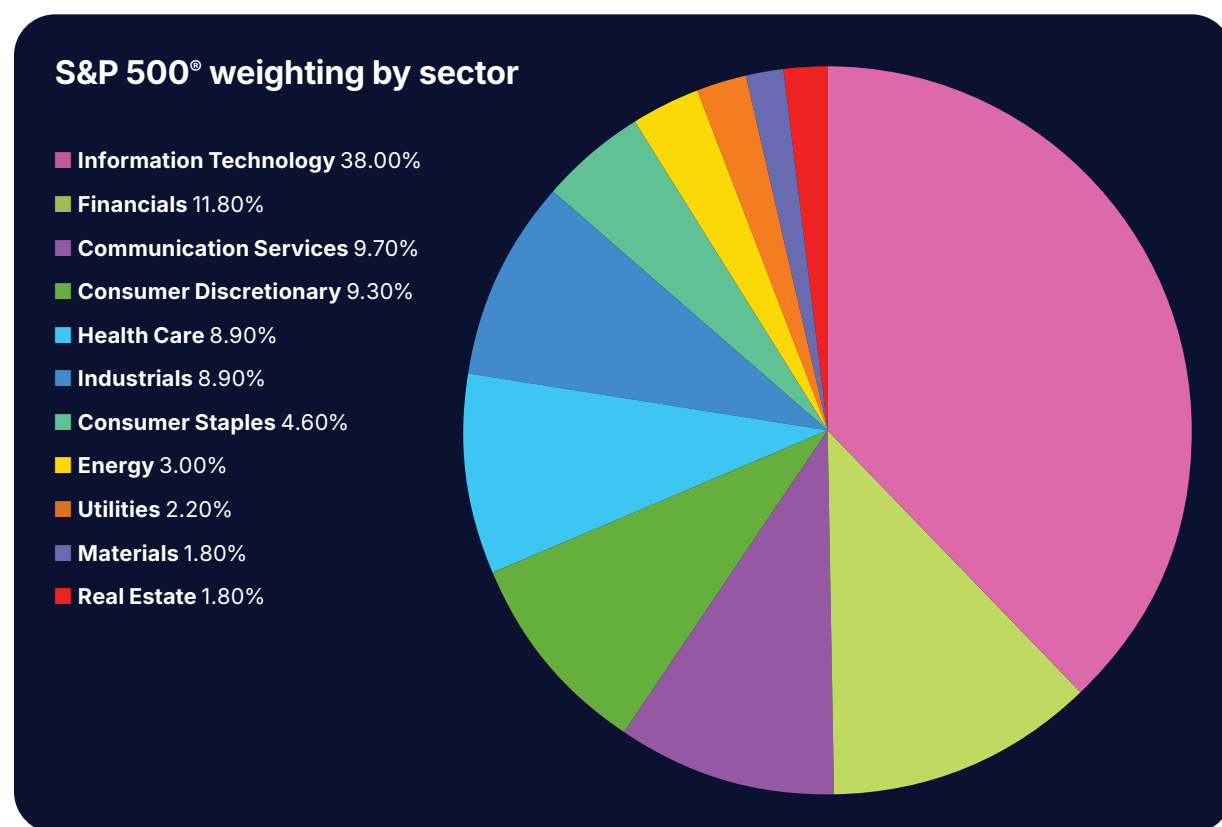
Carve out a portion of US equity exposure for sectors

Glossary

Gross Expense Ratio: The fund's total annual operating expense ratio. It is gross of any fee waivers or expense reimbursements. It can be found in the fund's most recent prospectus.
