Capture AI economic benefits in Tech and beyond - XNTK

The lead

- The S&P 500 climbed to new highs in October driven by the Magnificent Seven stocks as expectations for increased AI spending and productivity gains continued to underpin the market
- Information Technology and Communication Services sectors have led Al innovation and earnings growth over the past two years¹ and are expected to contribute 48% of the S&P 500 EPS growth in 2026²
- By providing equal-weighted exposure to Tech leaders across Information Technology, Consumer
 Discretionary and Communication Services sectors, the <u>State Street® SPDR® NYSE Technology ETF</u>
 (XNTK) may help investors capture the broader economic benefits of increasing AI investment and adoption


The takeaway

US-led AI development may continue to provide growth opportunities for companies well positioned to take advantage of AI technologies. To capture these potential growth opportunities, investors need to look beyond the Magnificent Seven stocks and traditionally defined Information Technology sector.

Year to date, XNTK has outperformed the Bloomberg Magnificent Seven Index by 17%, the Nasdaq 100 Index by 20% and the S&P 500 by 26% (see Chart of the Week).³ The Magnificent Seven represent only 18% of XNTK's portfolio, compared to 36% of the S&P 500 Index and 45% of the Nasdaq 100 Index.⁴ XNTK also provides a way for investors to access AI beneficiaries beyond US borders like Alibaba, TSMC, and Shopify.
